# Dovbush School of Ukrainian Dance (DSUD) Association of United Ukrainian Canadians (AUUC)

#### Dress Code for All Classes:

## Zaychyky, Bilka, Zirka

➤Girls: ballet pink tights, pink ballet slippers (leather) and a black leotard (sleeveless or short sleeve). A dance skirt (wrap skirt or elasticized waistband) may be worn. Long hair must be put into a **bun** for all classes; however, preschoolers may have their hair in a ponytail or braid. Hair must be secured off the face, no matter its length.

➤ Boys: black dance tights or fitted athletic pants, black ballet slippers (leather preferable) and a white t-shirt.

## Veselka, Yalynka (in addition to the above)

➤ Character footwear (shoes & short heels)

Girls Character: Bloch Karacta Character Shoe – Low Heel S0315 (3/4" heel) Boys Character: Capezio E-Series Black Leather Oxford Jazz Shoe (or similar)

#### Druzhba

➤ Character footwear (shoes & boots)

Girls Character: Black Leather Character shoe (heel should be no higher than 1.5". Bloch Karacta Canvas Character Shoe  $-1\,\%$ " Heel is accepted). May consider Kozachok Women's Full Sole Character Shoe Traditional Heel (postmarkukraine.com) as foot growth slows. Red boots. Boys Character: Red boots. May consider Hopachok Men's Full Sole Dance Boot (postmarkukraine.com) as foot growth slows.

## PLEASE NOTE: NEW TO the 2021-2022 SEASON!

- >We will be unable to leave our Shoe Bin out for everyday use. There is still access to our supply; however, we will require families sign out shoes to take home for the duration of the dance season (as needed). Sizes limited.
- Students must bring a water bottle (labeled with their name) to class to avoid having anyone drink directly from a tap.

## Please respect class time:

- > Ensure dancers arrive on time in proper attire (hair up, no jewelry, proper dance strip etc.)
- > Arriving late to class can be disruptive and difficult on the groups' progression in learning.
- > Keep noise and activity in entrance to a minimum.

#### Communication:

#### Attendance:

- Absences affect not only the student but also the entire class, especially when working on performance material.
- Absences in an activity-based class can't easily be made up each missed class results in missing valuable instruction, the opportunity to practice important technique, placement, steps, and choreography.

#### MASKS – we will continue to monitor and adhere to BC's recommendations:

➤ Optional for children under the age of 12 or 12+ and fully vaccinated (including 14 day monitoring period).

## Illness & Holidays:

- > NEW TO 2021-2022 SEASON: Dancers are not permitted to enter the building if:
  - They have a fever, cough, difficulty breathing, cold or sneezing. Please stay at home!
  - They have been outside the country in the past 14 days
  - They have been in close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19
  - They have a family member sick at home.
- Review the School Calendar and please give consideration to closure dates when planning holidays.
- A minimum 48-hour notice should be given to the Dovbush School of Ukrainian Dance (DSUD) via email (danceschool@auucvancouver.ca) or telephone (604 254-3436.)
- > Sudden absence due to illness or incident a message should be given as soon as possible.
- > Giving no notice is an unexcused absence.
- When a dancer accumulates 3 absences, we reserve the right to disallow the dancer to perform in any concert and reserve the right to remove the dancer from choreography.

#### Parents Observation Day:

➤ During the 2021-2022 dance season, we will anticipate holding a Parents Observation Day. We will continue to adhere to health orders throughout the season and will update families via e-mail regarding confirmation of the date and the Day's procedures. In the event that we are unable to host this in person, a live showing virtually through Zoom may be explored.

#### Performances:

At this time, we are unable to confirm any performance dates in-person at the hall. We are considering digital options, but will continue to monitor the situation.

## • Competition:

- \*\*BCUCF has not yet updated their competition information, but currently hosts this event on the first Sunday of May (that being May 7, 2022). We will continue to monitor this event and its potential plans for possible participation\*\*
- ➤ If your child's class is chosen to compete in the BCUCF competition in Mission, it is imperative that he or she participates in this competition (competition fees are included in our registration fee).

- Attendance at all regular classes and special rehearsals for competition classes is mandatory. Please advise the School by January 8 if your child is unable to commit to a competition class, or the BCUCF competition date.
- > Additional rehearsals may be required prior to the competition.
